The coverup continues, eh? Clarence Kelley, F. B. I. director, has reviewed the JFK assassination files and found all is well — no questions, no conspiracy, case closed. If Mr. Kelley had bothered to read his own F. B. I. file of a report of Dec. 9, 1963 (Exhibit 23) he would have found evidence to totally shatter the Warren

Report. It states that President Kennedy was hit by a bullet which "had entered just below his shoulder to the right of the spinal column at an angle of 45 to 60 degrees downward, that there was no point of exit . . ." The Commission decided this bullet not only exited JFK's throat, but went on to inflict Connally's wounds. How else explain what every doctor who saw it called an entrance wound in the throat?

The final autopsy report has the shoulder wound moved up to the base of the neck — while the chart still has it situated in the back. Moving bullet holes? Or what two-thirds of the witnesses said they heard — shots from the front? So who is lying — the F. B. I. or the Warren Commission?
