JFK assassination records appeals Harold Veisberg 8/7/79
FRI refusal to search proper HQ and field office files - bad faith
Artitrariness and capriciousness, in searches and exemptions claimed

In prior appeals that have not been acted upon I have specified files the FHI refused to search at HQ and the field offices. By providing illustrations from records that were released I have identified a number of these files. I have illustrated the arbitrariness and capriciousness of the claims to exception, including privacy, and have appealed spurious claims to exception by showing that more defauntory information relating to others (including me) was released. In this I add to these former appeals and to my prior appeals relating to the withhelding of information on or about Clay Many.

Attached is 62-109060-4589, from Section 113. With same record is unrecorded in Section 231 of 105-82555, from which I also attach 5545.

For you to fully appreciate the deliberateness of the FHI's mfusal to search to known files that are relevant I provide a bit of background. Nore is available if you desire it. I regard this as having additional historical importance because by untruth the FHI sought to make liars of the then new Attorney General, Clark, and George lardner, whose reporting of what was embarrassing to the FHI was accurate. As a result the existing public record is that both Clark and Lardner were not accurate whereas they were.

About Narch 1, 1967, as he left his confirmation hearing, Clark was asked about Clay Shew and Clay Sertrand. On the basis of FRI information he then said they were one and the same. This was a few weeks after knowledge of the Carrison investigation was public. The FRI had known of it for months.

The FHI recented any investigation because any investigation reflected on the FEI's earlier investigation. Apparently it did not anticipate that the AG would disclose what it had told him - and the White House. So about three menths later the FHI issued a statement in which it denied what its own records, as illustrated by the attached, in fact do state and what it had told the AG and the White House. That statement was made to Clay Shaw's lawyers, who made it public, if the FHI did not disclose it first.

While as I have informed you Carrison needed no help in gping wrong by this and by

other mount it Cointelprood him. The degree to which this was done openly with those the FEI trusted is reflected in what I proviously informed you about, virtual parties at the New Orleans field office participated in by parsonau ranging from David Formie to reporters trusted by the field office. As I told you I have the notes of one such reporter.

In 4589 the Director informed the White House of the FHI's "data alleging that Clay Shew is identical with Clay Bartrand..." On the seme day there is the radio message from the Sem Entenic office, there is this language: "Herep March 25, 1964 (emphasis added) page 15 reflects and andistic, massochistic, and hospecual character of May Shew, reported arrested yesterday." And while I do not regard homosexuality as having any connection with the assessmention leaself, there is this language from the memo attached to the letter to the White House: "One source informed this Europe on March 10, 1964 (esphasis added) that he has had relations of a homosexual mature with Clay Shew."

Phis and similar information is withheld from the New Orleans and Dallas records provided in C.A. s 78-0322 and 0420. The basis for these statements, which exist in underlying records at FERRI, also remain the following from me, to the best of my knowledge. I have ready many but not all the FERRI records. That Dallas files hold such records does not rest alone on the securition of the following of usual practice in providing records to the Office of Origin. Son Antonio's radio message was sent to Dallas and New Orleans, not only FERRIS.

The PhI's manipulation of the media, public efficials and what the country could know and would believe in many instances was more important to it and occupied more of its time and effort than its proper function, law conferencest. I believe this is a point significent factor in FOIA requests and appeals, my might instabling this emphasis in the hope that you will expedite this and related appeals because they relate to engoing litigation and because false FAI representations to the courts is its norm.

The seme sent to the White House misrepresents parts of this where it provides a less than homest regresentation of what the lawyer Dean Andrews actually said. Contrary to the thrust and language of this meso andrews was confirmed, including to the FMT, by not fewer than three many people directly and indirectly by others. Andrews testified to the Warren Consission that the FM papelied such pressures on him that he decided the only way to get it off his back was to tell it enything it wanted to hear. The building and Shaw had GIA connections that were not public knowledge and relating to which the FM still withholds information.

(In this connection I will be providing you with further information having to do with the Cawald associate in his propaganda activities I carry in what " have identified to you as my "Third Han" file and with the content of the WDSU-TV Osuald footage that no longer exists but is described as broadcast by the FeI's records in the Sections

from which the attached records come.)

The VIII did not provide the Warren Cormission with the information is gave the AG and the White House although the relevance of this "Clay Bertmand" information is obvious, as is the PHI's motive in attempting to destroy Dean Andrews credibility over what he said about Clay Bertmand and testified to.

I underscored the date above to emphasize that this was long before Carrison and was prior to Andrews tentisony before the Commission.

Whether or not Show was an FET source, as I believe he was and would have been right and proper, to by knowledge the FED had other sources in Show's offices. With the kinds of people the Show office brought to New Orleans, like Samoza, informing the FET was necessary. Hence of this is in the records not still withheld. Covering that was virtually a beat for since retired SA Warren DeBrusys. As I have also informed you this is relevant in a New Tork FOTA case the complaint in which Mr. Leenr has and can provide, although your critice has knowledge from the appeal.

I also call your attention to the fact that while the full was very much lose than homest and did withhold from the Presidential Commission and has withhold since, once then was charged it immediately beasted to the White Bouse that "we know all about this all along." ASSASSIBATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN FITZGERALD EXHERDY MOVEMBER 22, 1963, BALLAS, TEXAS

This Bureau received allegations as early as 1954 that Clay Shaw, former managing director of the International Trade Mart in New Orleans, Louisiana, was a homosexual. One source informed this Bureau on March 19, 1964, that he has had relations of a homosexual nature with Clay Shaw. The source described Shaw as a brilliant and powerful man, given to sadism and masochism in his homosexual activities. On February 24, 1967, we received information from two other sources that information available to them led them to believe Clay Shaw has homosexual tendencies.

On February 24, 1967, we received information from two sources that Clay Shaw reportedly is identical with an individual by the same of Clay Pertrand, who allegedly was in contact with Dean Andrews, a New Orleans attorney, in connection with Lee Harvey Oswald, the facts of which are as follows:

On Movember 25, 1963, Andrews informed Agents of this Bureau that he had met Lee Harvey Oswald in late June, 1963, at which time Oswald appeared at his office with several individuals who impressed him as being homosexuals. Andrews claimed that Oswald requested assistance in making inquiries concerning Oswald's bad conduct discharge from the United States Marine Corps. Andrews further stated that Oswald asked him questions concerning the citizenship status of Oswald and his wife.

Andrews further stated that on the evening of Movember 23, 1963, at which time he was in a hospital in New Orleans under heavy sedation, he received a telephone call from an individual who said his name was Clay Bertrand. We added that Bertrand asked him if he would be interested in handling the defense of Lee Marvey Oswald in Dallas, Texas, for the murder of President Kennedy

We conducted extensive investigation concerning the data furnished by Andrews and could find no supporting evidence that Lee Harvey Oswald ever visited Andrews' (1) office. There was no record of Oswald in Andrews' files and his secretary could not recall Oswald ever having been to the office. In addition, we determined from Andrews' doctor that during the period Andrews was in the hospital he was seriously ill and was under heavy sedation. The doctor informed us that he did not believe Andrews was capable of using a telephone on November 23, 1963.

We questioned Andrews again on December 3, 1963, concerning his alleged association with Lee Harvey Oswald. On that date, Andrews stated that, after considering all the facts and discussing the matter with other members of his office staff, he believed the entire incident concerning the telephone call he received from Clay Bertrand could have been dreamed by him in view of his physical condition at that time.

We conducted extensive investigation in an effort to locate an individual by the name of Clay Bertrand but were unable to do so. Results of our investigation were furnished to the Warren Commission and Andrews was called as a witness before the Commission.
