Improper withholdings - inconsistency, arbitrariness and capriciousness Clay Shaw/Clay Bertaund; Frontiss Davie; Andre Shaw; Mario Bermudes

In enother appeal dated today I address Davis and Andrews in connection with Clay Shaw and records not provided and searches not cade.

Attached are two copies of the same record from different files reflecting ingroper and unjustified withholdings from one version that are not withhold in the other version. I regard this as more than more inconsistency, as arbitrariness and capriclousness with the intent of obfuscating and confusing in an area of some sensitivity if not potential soute embarrassment to the FML.

Here also I want to repeat that Clay Shaw and his ITM and associates there were requely FMI sources (I believe properly and necessarily so although I also believe that bocause of this the FMI foured asherraressent once Shaw was charged) and that the CIA had admitted a associately innocent relationship with Clay Shaw prior to the processing and providing of the attached records.

I will also provide a separate but related appeal having to do with Jesus Core, in addition to similar prior appeals.

For your information, the FNI-MIN relationship involved retired SA Warren C. De Brusys who is involved in a case filed in Mew York. As I have told you, Fr. Legar has a copy of that complete if you do not.

Attached are 62-109060-4608 and the first page of the Not Recorded copy from 105-82555 62-109060-4612. (I have already provided a San Antonic record that is relevant and perhaps a copy of the of the attached in connection with an earlier related appeal.)

If you require more of an axplanation relating to Clay Pertrand than I have provided I can offer more information.

I have provided the first page only of the duplicate record because there are no withholdings from the subsequent pages. Also, they disclose what is withhold from 4608. While the file identification of the duplicate copy indicated on 4008 is too unclear for certainty some of the numbers do not appear to be those of that file.

The so-called "facts that follow the first page are notther accurate nor complete. One is proven to be false, that Andrews was not able to use the phone. He did, several times, as the FoI know but omits from this record. Among the incompletenesses is the fact that Oswald's consultation with Andrews also included how to get into Herico and Oswald appears to have used this advice. Others are that Oswald was accompanied by another person and thatk some of Andrews' homoshaual aliento also were present. From what Andrews told me and is not in any FMI records I've seen there was still more.

Sextal 4612 appears to be exceptional. ¹⁶0 copies are indicated for New Orleans or the Office of Origin, Dalles. On November 25, 1963, Mr. Andrews informed Agents of our New Drienge. Office that he had met Lee Harvey Oswald in late June, 1962, at which time Oswald appeared at his office with neveral individuals who impressed him as being homosexamily. Andrews claimed that Oswald requested athistunce in making inquiries concerning his bad conduct discharge from the United States Marine Corps. Andrews nino indicated that Obwald asked him guestions concerning the citizenable states of he and his wife.

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Andrews further stated that on the evening of November 23, 1962, at which time he was in the hospital in New Orteans, maler heavy sedation, he received a telephone ____ call from an individual who sold his name was Clay Dertrand who naked him if he whild be interested in handling the defense of the Harvey Oswald in Dallas, Texas, for the munder of President Kennedy.

We conducted extensive investigation concerning the data furnished by Andrews and could find no supporting evidence that see thankey Onwald had ever visited Andrews! office. There was no record of Oswald in Andrews' files and his secretary could not recall Oswald ever having been to the office th addition, we determined from Andrews! doctor that during the period Andrews was in the hospital he way under extreme sedation and he did not believe Andrews was capable of asing a telephone on November 23, 1963. Andrews was questioned again on December 3, 1963, coucerning hip alleged annoctation with Lee Harvey Oswald and Andrews stated after considering the facts in discussions with his office, stalf he betteved the entire incident could have been dreamed by him in view of the physical condition he was in at the time.

We conducted extensive investigation in an effort to locate an Individual by the name of Clay Dertrand but were unable to do so. Repairly of our investigation were furnished to the Warren Commission and Andrews was called as a witness before the Commission. In the Warren Commissions report his testimony was noted with emphasis upon the facts tending to show the unlike hipped of his having contact with Lee Harvey Oswald. ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY NOVEMBER 22, 1963 DALLAS, TEXAS

On March 1, 1967, atll:05 p.m., Andre SHaw, 417 West Yandell Street, El Paso, Texas, advised that he was a former associate of Clay Shaw, the man arrested in New Orleans, Louisiana as a possible accomplice of Lee Harvey Oswald. He stated that one Mario Bermudez, who lives in New Orleans, was a friend of Clay Shaw's and that he might know something of interest to authorities. He stated that Bermudez was connected with the Trade-Mart in New Orleans, and could possibly be reached at New Orleans telephones 523-1689 and CANAL 3591.

On March 2, 1967, Mr. Shaw advised that he was no relation of Clay Shaw.
