5/10/67 Did a three-hour radio show on WBEM Chicago by phone last night. If you do not know it, this Don Cannon show has a very large oudience in most of the states. He gave me a chance to respond to Phelsm and I convinced him it was not an impartisl piece of writing. Apparently I also convinced his sudience, two too, for in the call-ins there was not a single call raflecting any sympathy for Fhelan's point of view, nor wes there one that in any way showed being influenced by him ... As you know, my mail and phone services are not what they should be, whother or not they are interfered with. The phone was particularly bad and obviously so last hight. They commented, apontaneously, because apparently their maters inAlicated something. This gave me an apportunity to comment on the kind of opposition I have hed and what is happening to you, including in extradition. All of this bracketed with part of the story of New Orleans and the people involved the producer thinks we'de exciting radio. I got a chance to say theh kind of people you are, how you work, to my own observation, etc., and I think it was good public relations for you. I'll be doing more, and it is more then a way of offsetting the intellectual finkery. Perhaps, sometime, if you'd like, when I'm doing something like this, we can arrange a conference phone connection and you can be phoned in on the program. A short appearance would not take much of your time and would not be undignified. Let ma know.
