Appropos of Moo's call, within 24 hours after the man calls me, I'll be on my way. I'll make tentative arrangements today when I am in DC.

He and I made two long tapes and obtained a third. I have arranged for the transcription of these tapes. The shortest one is on the way. As soon as I can dub the other two, they also will be taken care of.

Inclosed is a copy of a letter I have written Bobby. It was 4:30 this morning when I finished it and I haven't taken time to reread it, so I hope it is what I intended. He is a consummate fool, an unspeakable scoundrel, and indescribable coward, or a combination. Time will tell us which. Whatever, this and what he did down there will ultimately help.

My own belief is that whatever or whatever combination he is, he is also, in addition, at the very least also a captive of his adviser(s). He is not stupid. What he has done is. He had to have had considerable help to have done what cannot possibly help him and cannot possibly avoid hurting him.
