Dear Jim,

When they turn on in Washington, we have entered a new year if not a new era. I did 2 1/2 hours on Washington radio and, among the things I learned, is that the FBI immediately interviewed G.C. Shufar and then told her to keep quiet. She is a former Ruby stripper and practicing whore reportedly recently married.

She used the "professional" name "GaeGee" and may have "danced" under the pseudo-Indian names (did "Indian" dance) of Salomina or Cochise.

The last known address was Cherry Hill (I'm not putting you on), N.J. This is near Camden, which is across the Delaware River from Philadelphia.

Tomorrow I am to meet the man who knows her, who has a picture of her with a group of people. She is partly dressed. If I get the picture, I am not to use the faces of the others. I am also to get a tape of her conversing with three or four other people about this, including her interview by the FBI. I recall no such reports, which does not mean they do not exist.

Assuming these things to be true, I have and expect to say of authenticating her.

She is said to have said that she worked for Ruby the month of two before the assassination and to have been fired by " Oswald". I wonder if here again "Oswald" may not have been Oswald.

The roads were passable last night-this a.m. It is now below zero. Assuming there is no more snow, for I am almost snowbound now, I have a date to meet this man and pick these things up Wednesday p.m.

Also, I have located a man who is both a photography buff and a jazz addict. In August 1962 he took extensive pictures inside Dixieland Hall. You may recall that Clark told me he had at about this time been introduced to Oswald by Dean Andrews. While it is perhaps expecting too much to think these pictures, taken of the musicians-for the most part, will show other interesting people, I hope to be able to get good contemporaneous pictures of Clark and Tolson for you. I'll let you know when I see the pictures.

On this show I accused the government of first looking what it represented as your records through the CIA because it was first used by Jerry Wiener the second day before the Chitrib story appeared. I also charged that someone in the executive branch had better take the thinking away from the Department of Dirty Trick, which is interested in its own preservation alone and has little regard for the reputation or future of LBJ. This is the longest "talk" show ever aired in Washington. There was not a single person who phoned in with a question or any comment favorable to the other side! While I was broadcasting, the station called me up to hear my speech. I hope they use it.
