Harold Weisberg, Hyattstown author, well known for
his writings on the Kennedy assassination, has praised Jim
Garrison, New Orleans district
attorney for urging a Senate
investigation into the death of
the former President.

Garrison, in an interview with
the New Orleans States Item,
on Monday, urged that the claim
that the Central Intelligence
Agency withheld information from the Warren Commission be the focal point for a fullscale investigation.

Weisberg, who returned home
Tuesday after an appearance before the Grand Jury in New
Orleans, had written in his
hooks that there was involvement with the CIA and has been
urging Senate investigation.

Garrison also agreed with the
Weisberg position that there had
been a coverup by the Federal
investigative agencies.

Weisberg said the New Orleans papera have given credit
to the local man for his exposure
of the part played by the FBI
agents.

Weisberg said he found Garrison and his staff a hard working group which is going into
much detail in their investigation of the assassination.
