Dear Jim,

Checked the Milteer data today. Do not know if you have or not so pending getting the documents, which I will have for you if you do not have them, this, briefly, is the story:

He was seen in Jacksonville railroad station at 25 p.m. 11/22/63 by the informant, who he told he had not been kidding, that it had happened just the way he said it would.

He was interviewed by the FBI 11/26 and at that time indicated the man who would have done the shooting is one Jack H. Brown, of Chattanooga. Naturally, there is no file on this Jack Brown but there are files on two others: the former AGVA man in Dallas and one whose in-laws are the T.A. Yateses, of Texas (this one lives at 9812 Wildhaven, 1 Dallas). I've been in touch with Art to get him to ask Skip if there could be any connection between this family and the Gally (Wiley) he mentioned to me.

This stuff is scattered through several files, one devoted to nuts, a rather large one, and another illuminatingly headed, "Lee Harvey Oswald-Internal Security-Russia".

Interestingly, one of the "nut" cases is an accurate forecast from inside Leavenworth of the JFK assassination and how it would turn out, dated 10/8/68.

Part of each file is withheld at the request of your friendly FBI.

Milteer was also interviewed 11/27, at Suitman, Co., when he told the FBI he had "attended a national meeting of the Congress of Freedom, New Orleans, La." during April 1963, at the invitation of a "Mr. Thomas, Chairman of the organization, Omaha, Nebraska." Of course, he told the FBI he had never threatened or heard anyone threaten the President!

Interesting file on TSBD Pres. Jack Charles Mason ("very conservative"), whose wife "made a remark to the effect that someone ought to shoot President KENNEDY"....WAMU, Wash., has broadcast your AU speech to the Nat Educ Radio Net in two parts and the Wash Post gave each a highlight in its listings! I was in N.O. for first part. Second, last night, was very good.
