(Comment: HALL has been arrested on bad check charges, for possession of pharmaceuticals of the "pep-pill" type, for transporting arms, for non-payment of rent, etc. Some who know him believe that his statements about having been a soldier of fortune in Cuba are lies. His father said that he had once had a "mental breakdown" and was subject to severe depression.)

- c. The Los Angeles Times reported en 27 January 1968 that Garrison's request for the return of Subject from Kernville, California, to New Orleans had been denied.
- d. On 1 May 1968 the same newspaper stated that Subject then said that his memory had recently been "jogged" and that he could recall discussions of assassinations and that he was considering going to New Orleans to make his information available to Garrison.
- 4. Subject has not been associated with CIA.
- 5. In respect to HALL's story about Mrs. Sylvia ODID, he first claimed that he was one of three men who called on her in Dallas in September 1963, then claimed that he had not done so.
