
Garrison and the Kennedy Assassination: William Clarence WOOD, Jr., aka William BOXLEY

1. The New York <u>Times</u> of 12 July 1968, p. C 35, carried an article headlined "Garrison Claims Foreign Spy Link". The article includes the following:


> "Over the telephone, Mr. Garrison also introduced an investigator for his office, Bill Boxley, as a former Central Intelligence Agency instructor in the 'clandestine operations department'. He said he had found Mr. Boxley while seeking a 'man who had been with the intelligence agency but still cared about the United States'.

> "Mr. Boxley then said his real name was William C. Wood; he was 48 years old, originally from Texas; he had worked 10 years as a newspaper reporter--last on The Denver Post from 1948 to 1950; he had been with the intelligence agency two to five years in the **1970** (10) verseas and in Washington and had 'used as many as 10 different names in operations with the agency'."

Reference is made to your letter dated July 25, entitled "Garrison and the Kennedy Assassination: 63 T.M. 50 1968 Villiam Clarence Food, Jr., ska Villiam Bexley," year reference the state of the st use, sector 4039 Wood which might be in possession of this Bureau.

The files of this Duroou disclose that the "Berkeley Barb," a neveraper published by the Underground Press Byndicate, in its imme of December 20, 1967-January 4, 1968, contained an article entitled "Mafia Plot to Kill Garrison Verified." The article identifies Mill Boxley as an investigator for Garrison, who verified the plot.

This Deress's files also disclose that one James Themas Mays, who was identified as a missing witness in a marder trial in Minni, Florida, during March, 1968, involving Antheny Reporti, had been interviewed by a news reporter for the "Miani News" and William Decley, an reperter for the "Hind Neve" and villing below, an investigator working for Jamos C. Gerrison, the New OFI District Attorney conducting the probe into the death of President Honnedy. In this connection the, "Hinni Neve" for Harch 5, 1965, indicated that Mays claimed he had h offered \$25,000 to kill Procident Honnedy but that he h refused the offer.
