On 10 December 1968 the New Orleans Times-Picayune carried an article reporting that Garrison had fired WOOD because "evidence recently developed... indicated current activity by him as an operative of the Central Intelligence Agency." The same newspaper quoted WOOD, aka BOXLEY, on 12 December 1968 as saying that he had "not been involved with the CIA or any federal agency since 1952".
