Garrison in New Orleans, I thought you would be interested in the attached memorandum which sets forth information made available to a representative of this Bureau by Mr. Frank W. Manning, Chief Investigator for Attorney General Jack P. F. Gremillion of Louisiana. The information made available by Mr. Manning is not within the jurisdiction of the FBI and is a matter which should be handled by state authorities, it being noted that they have had this information for some period of time. I have directed a letter to Mr. Manning advising him that the information concerning sex 1967 deviates and possible shakedown of these deviates is not a matter within the jurisdiction of the FBL, but a matter for state suthorities and should be thoroughly investigated by them.
