REMARKS

I drafted a possible reply if one is warranted to the FBI's memo. Herb has had conversations with the FBI which conveys the following: (1) They will persist in confining their inquiry to a "full" investigation of the 3 specific areas. (2) They have some strange notion that they are "protecting" us (and themselves) from wandering into super-sensitive and potentially embarrassing areas. I have no concept of what this apprehension is based on. (3) The Bureau will continue to try to push us into a grand jury so that they can take a secondary role in the investigation.
