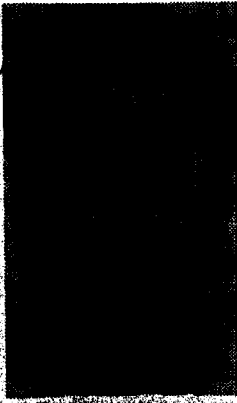

Garrison Appeal

NEW ORLEANS—The Louisiana Supreme Court has ordered a trial of New Orleans District Attorney Jim Garrison's claim that his bid for re-election was defeated by fraud.

The unanimous decision was handed down two hours after a hearing on arguments by lawyers for Garrison and for Harry Connick, victor in the Dec. 15 Democratic runoff.

The seven justices reversed a Court of Appeal ruling which held that Garrison's challenge was not trialworthy because he did
