

MEMORANDUM

January 31, 1967

RE: SPECIAL INVESTIGATION, DALLAS

On January 23, 1967, I contacted a Mr. Watts, Assistant District Attorney for Dallas County, Dallas, Texas. I told him that I was in Dallas on a Narcotics investigation and that I would be speaking to various individuals in Dallas, concerning said investigation. I asked that he verify my identity if called on, and he gave me his card and assured me that he would help in any way possible. He was very cooperative.

I next proceeded to the 3100 block of Earlandale Avenue in Dallas and discovered that there was no such number as 3128 in that block. I spoke to neighbors and showed the pictures to them. They could not identify anyone. This area is comprised of one family, wooden structures and would be classified as a lower middle income neighborhood. There are some Spanish speaking persons in this block but the majority of residents appear to be of Anglo Saxon extraction.

I proceeded to the El Chico restaurant at 110 West Davis Street. This is one of a chain of restaurants featuring Mexican food throughout the Southwest. The time was approximately 12:00 P. M. and the restaurant was extremely crowded. I showed the photos to some of the employees who had been employed there for a period in excess of three years. No identification was made.

I contacted the manager of the Dallasite Hotel located at 4126 North Central Expressway. He located his records for 1962. I carefully examined all of the registration cards with special emphasis on September 25, 1962. I discovered no names which were significant or any information on any of the cards which I could connect to this investigation.

I also checked the Highlander Apartment-Hotel located at 4217 Lomo Alto. I received no cooperation from the personnel there and was only able to view the records after locating the manager, Mrs. Frankfort. They have the names of those persons who registered on more than one occasion during the months of September, October, November, and December of 1962.

While in Dallas I also checked on the Brownlee aspect of this case and learned that a Brownlee had lived at 1030 N. Clinton Street, Dallas, Texas with the first name Jerry and that he lived in Houston, Texas. I learned that he was an investigator.
