

MEMORANDUM

February 8, 1967

I arrived on the stake-out at 8:00 P. M. on February 8, 1967, at 3331 Louisiana Avenue. I was met by Mrs. Wish and observed the subject lying on a couch from 8:05 P. M. until about 9:10 P. M. Subject was attired in only long sleeve white shirt. At about 9:10 P. M. subject left room and came back with what appeared to be a cup of coffee. Subject returned to couch and got up at about 10:15 at which time subject moved to the other side of room. At this point investigator could not make out what subject was doing. Subject could have been on phone. After a short while subject returned to couch. At 11:15 P. M., subject jumped up and returned to other side of room as if to answer phone (This is only an assumption) After about five minutes or at 11:20, subject got up, walked around the room and sat in a chair, and it appeared to me that the subject was removing eyebrows. At about 11:40 P. M., subject got up and removed two pillows and a blanket and placed same on floor, removed his shirt and at this time, he was in the nude. He turned off the lights and retired for the night. During the surveillance, no one came to the residence nor did the subject leave. I left the stake-out at 11:55 P. M.
