Says RFK Obstructs JFK Probe

NEW YORK - (UPD - Sen. Robert F. Kennedy has "done everything he could to obstruct" the investigation of President Kennedy's assassination, New Orleans District Attorney Jim Garrison charged here yesterday.

"It is quite apparent to me that for one reason or another he does not want the truth to be brought out," Garrison said in an interview. "Perhaps he can explain better than I can why his political career is so important."

Because of Kennedy's alleged attempts to obstruct the controversial Garrison probe, "I have to conclude that he feels the development of truth about the assassination, eatching the real assassigs of now the Clemband Prices

Jack Kennedy, would interfere with his political career," the district attorney said.

Garrison said he knows the names of men involved in the alleged plot to assassinate Kennedy. He said, "Most of them are in Texas; and Dallas particularly, where they are protected — one, by the Dallas law entorcement establishment, and two, by the Federal Government."

He charged that the slaying of the President in Dallas "was a Nazi operation whose sponsors included some of the oil-rich millionaries in Texas," and added that "elements of the Dallas police force are clearly involved.
