PHONE THREATS TOLD BY RAULT

Says Financial Backers of Probe Get Calls

Members of "Truth and Con-sequences," an organiza-tion backing District Atty. Jim Garrison's current, probe of the assassination of President John F. Kennedy, have received threatening phone calls, accord-ing to Joseph M. Rault Jr., an organizer of the group.

Rault did not reveal how many members had been called or just what the threats were.

Rault, who has known Garri-son for 18 years, was a leader in organizing the businessmen's efforts to finance Garrison's i probe, the first chapter of which was unfurled Tuesday at the Coiming Counts bldg. Acked Criminal Courts bldg. Asked how large is the total of con-tributions, Rault replied, "I don't know, but the money and checks are still coming in."

Other key organizers of the group were Willard E. Robert-son and Cecil H. Shilstone. The

son and Cecil H. Shilstone. The base group numbered 50 of New Orleans' leading businessmen, willing to put up \$100 a month for "at least three months." Rault said he did not attend the preliminary hearing Tues-day. He pointed to a newspaper and said, "I'm keeping up with it through this." "I could have gotten a seat."

"I could have gotten a seat," said Rault, "but I didn't figure that would be the right thing to do. We wanted to back our district attorney, and we're go-ing to let him do it the way he wants to do."

Referring again to the threat-ening calls, Rault agreed they could have been from cranks. "I hope so," he said, "but we've got a lot of nuts."
