## Garrison Aide -18 Enters D.A. Race

NEW ORLEANS, June 18 (UPI)—The chief assistant of District Attorney Jim Garrison plans to resign and run against Garrison this November.

Charles R. Ward said he had been given Garrison's assurance that he would be recommended for a state judgeship. However, Garrison withdrew his support Monday, saying Ward was accused of accepting bribes.

Ward refused to take part in the Kennedy assassination probe that was climaxed by the acquittal of Clay Shaw.
