Garrison sees this as putting
him in Washington . . . big pol-
itics," Novel said.

"The whole Garrison investi-
gation thing is fiction," Novel
added. "I know the full story
from working as the prosecu-
tor's security chief."

(Garrison says Novel never
worked for him.)

Novel, wanted by Garrison as
a witness in the assassination
inquiry and arrested in the Co-
lumbus area on a Louisiana
charge of conspiracy to commit
burglary, said Garrison wants
him returned to New Orleans
because "I know too much
about him."

At one point in the story, No-
vel said, "I think Garrison will
expose some CIA (Central Intel-
ligence Agency) operations in
Louisiana." He did not amplify
his statement.
