At 1:15 PM, 12/14/67, ASAC MASON WORKING, Albuquerque, furnished the following information:

At 11:35 AM, 12/14/67, Under-Sheriff DONALD SIMPSON informed that telephone operator ROSE QUINTERO, Bernalillo County Sheriff's Office, Albuquerque, received a long distance telephone call from an individual identifying himself as WILLIAM C. WOODS, speaking from New Orleans, Louisiana, Area Code 504, 822-2414, and identifying himself as an FBI Agent. This individual informed the Bernalillo County Sheriff's Office operator that JIM GARRISON, District Attorney, New Orleans, is in Albuquerque, New Mexico, staying at the Trade Winds Motel under the name of JOHN ARMSTRONG. WOODS stated he had received a telephone call indicating that at a mafia meeting on Thursday of last week it was decided to kill GARRISON. WOODS requested that the Bernalillo County Sheriff's Office protect GARRISON pending the arrival of WOODS and Assistant District Attorney LOU IVAN from New Orleans.

Sheriff's Office, Albuquerque, advised they are taking no action but were furnishing the information to the Albuquerque Police Department.
