Dry Leader Tried For Illegal Use Of Army Uniform

Edward Page Gaston 74, nationally prominent anti-saloon campaigner, went on trial in Municipal Court yesterday for illegally wearing the uniform of a United States Army captain and will take the stand today.

Three Government witnesses testified yesterday and Judge George D. Neilson adjourned court immediately after declining to direct a verdict of not guilty to the jury. The trial will be resumed at 10 a m.

Gaston, who resides at 1617 Rhode Island Avenue Northwest, was arrested here January 13 by FBI agents. Hé was accompanied to court by scores of fellow antisaloon campaigners.
