

Requested information concerning my personal background and a photograph of myself were furnished to him toge ther with the fact I am retiring effective 12/31/76.

No discussion was had concerning information not known to be available through public records. No discussion was had concerning sensitive investigative techniques, identity of informants, ongoing investigations or information received from another agency.

On 11/5/76 Dallas Times Herald Photographer WAYNE HERNICKA was permitted to photograph the file cabinets containing the numerous volumes of files relating to the KENNEDY ASSASSN ATION Investigation with the writer standing by same. No photographs were permitted where any of the contents of the files were visible. Such photographs were permitted after clearance from ASAC GLENN D. POSENCUIST.
