ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY, 11/22/63, DALLAS, TEXAS

MOORE of the Bureau called and advised that Asst. Director VILLIAN SULLIVAN has a friend in New Orleans named who advised SULLIVAN yesterday and a Cuban hand NANURL GIL, 620 Gravier St., New Orleans, supposedly known OSWALD and OSWALD supposedly called GIL on the telephome.

Inspector MOORE stated GIL should be interviewed for any information he has concerning OSWALD and that they be advised by phone or teletype today of results.

I advised Mr. MOORE that one of the persons listed in the group obtaining tourists cards for travel to Mexico is from Italy and MOORE said to just forget his name.

Orleans on 9/17 as he checked in at the Unemployment Breen and signed request for unemployment check, which check, according to employee at the Unemployment Bureau, would be mailed two or three days later, and it would seem OSWALD would be here to get the check.
