SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT  
JOHN F. KENNEDY, 11/22/63,  
DALLAS, TEXAS

At approximately 8:55 a.m., 11/27/63, Inspector **BOB MOORE** of the Bureau called and advised that Asst. Director **WILLIAM SULLIVAN** has a friend in New Orleans named [REDACTED] who advised SULLIVAN yesterday and a Cuban named **MANUEL GIL**, 620 Gravier St., New Orleans, supposedly known to **OSWALD** and **OSWALD** supposedly called GIL on the telephone.

Inspector **MOORE** stated GIL should be interviewed for any information he has concerning **OSWALD** and that they be advised by phone or teletype today of results.

I advised Mr. **MOORE** that one of the persons listed in the group obtaining tourists cards for travel to Mexico is from Italy and **MOORE** said to just forget his name.

**MOORE** was advised that we know **OSWALD** was in New Orleans on 9/17 as he checked in at the Unemployment Bureau and signed request for unemployment check, which check, according to employee at the Unemployment Bureau, would be mailed two or three days later, and it would seem **OSWALD** would be here to get the check.
