Dear Miss Garrett:

On November 29, 1963, this Commission was established and authorized to investigate and report on all the circumstances surrounding the assassination of President Kennedy and the killing of the alleged assassin, Lee Harvey Oswald. One of our staff attorneys, Wesley J. Liebeler, plans to be in New Orleans on Tuesday, April 6, 1964. He will contact you shortly thereafter on all aspects of the assassination and of the background of the alleged assassin of which you may have knowledge.

For your information, I am enclosing copies of Senate Bill 11130 creating this Commission, S. J. Res. 137, and the Rules and Procedure of this Commission for the questioning of witnesses by members of the Commission staff.
