Dear Miss Barrett:

On November 29, 1963, this Commission was established and authorized to investigate and report on all the circumstances surrounding the assassination of President Kennedy and the killing of the alleged assassin, Lee Harvey Oswald. One of our chief attorneys, Wesley J. Liebeler, plans to be in New Orleans on Monday, April 6, 1964. He will contact you shortly thereafter on all aspects of the assassination and of the background of the alleged assassin of which you may have knowledge.

For your information, I am enclosing copies of Executive Order No. 11130 creating this Commission, S. J. Res. 127, and the Rules of Procedure of this Commission for the questioning of witnesses by members of the Commission staff.
