One part that should have been in the "es "ricens records provided and was not is that the night that Devid Ferrie died Philip was kidnepped by of all people this same Sergment Some and a New Orleans vice equal detective who was also a sermen Commission witness and, although the "ormission's seconds not not reflect this, to the best of my recol action, is the one who recruited Oswald into the Civil Air Patrol.

In this world of coincidences, Perrie was a CaP leader and four years before this kidnapping Philip was also in the same CAP in New Orleans.

The femily was in on the kidnapping because it had been persuaded that this was a measure of protection for Frailp and was on behalf of Carrison, who hadn't the slighest idea of it - fortunately.
