Thank you very much for your book, its inscription and your note. I appreciate them very much. And your book seems to be in general parallel with some of my recent thinking and writing. No time for many details. Books rather messed up on NEVER AGAIN! if you read about it in Case Open. After sitting on it for two years a sudden rush. They plan it for April.

Odd coincidence, only a few days ago I wrote Ray and Sznajp about my completed ms. of Motive, means and opportunity in Wake the Watchman: Our Strangelovian Military and the JFK Assassination. I do not expect an answer. They are hung up on the theoreticians and nuts and angry at me because I led to the campaign against Stone's movie that helped it. My only objection was that he said he would record their history for the people and tell him who killed their President, why and how. With Garrison and Harris, a total impossibility. If he had not said that I'd have said nothing. And while he got much attention he and his staff wound up ignorant of the fact of the assassination. No way to inform the people constructively.

Also a coincidence, I make the case as much as it can be made, I think, in this ms.

They'll probably print anything exciting on the subject but if you value your reputation on your followup be careful whose work you believe and use because most are fictions and some are worse.

I believe JFK was timid about nothing. But when he had to be after bad experiences he was cautious. So I have no trouble with the blurb for your book, which I'll start tomorrow in the little time I have for reading. And I do remember it took courage to go after the lout the way he did.

I do not believe that Wall Street per se was behind the assassination. I would have no trouble believing that some financial interests had some involvement.

For practical purposes, it was a coup d'etat.
