Known to have had dealings with Juan Erquiaga, owner of an armament factory  
Wanted for the theft of 1800 lbs of explosives which were recovered from his  
residence along with a cache of weapons and a supply of Minutemen literature  
(Attorney General of California, Para-Military Organizations in California, MM  
F-Library Shelf)

Seeking Gilbert for questioning about a telephone threat against the life of  
Martin Luther King the same day the dynamite was stolen from the Sylmar storage  
magazine.

Is convicted of an unprovoked club and gun attack on a Negro motorist at the  
intersection of Sunset and LaBrea in Hollywood, September, 1964 (KLAC special  
report; Hothead of Hatred; F-California)

With Minuteman Robert E. Emery, ran the Los Angeles Ordnance Depot in Los Angeles,  
explosives store, until arrested and convicted of stealing explosives, June 1968  
(Van Nuys, Calif. News, June 16, 1968) (F. Minutemen)
