For the information of Boston and New York, [redacted] of the "New York Times" recently contacted the Bureau making inquiry concerning Saxe and Power. He was told of the fugitive status of both subjects and current charges pending against them. He indicated that he was "on to something" but would not know for sure where it would lead for a couple of days, but that the FBI would be the first to know. [redacted] then asked if William M. Gilday was presently serving a life sentence for murder at Walpole State Prison in Massachusetts. He was told that Gilday is in Walpole and that he was associated with Saxe and Power in a Boston bank robbery. He said that they had received an anonymous communication which he was checking out. [redacted] was told that it was understood the "New York Times" would try to get the very best story possible out of this situation, but was also reminded that these two fugitives were being actively sought by the FBI and that it was our job to check out any information which might lead to their apprehension. It was pointed out to him that it could be a dangerous situation resulting in someone getting hurt, or if the two fugitives are in a specific location, flush them out. [redacted] assured that the FBI would be given the facts and that the "New York Times" would not risk interfering with our fugitive investigation.
