Attached for information of the Bureau are two (2) copies of a "Motion for Subpoena Duces Tecum To Issue" filed in Middlesex Superior Court, Cambridge, Mass., by WILLIAM N. GILDAY, Jr., on 1/3/76. A hearing on this motion is scheduled for 2/18/76, time not specified.

A copy of this motion has been furnished to AUSA WILLIAM BROWN, Boston, Mass., who is handling this matter.

As noted in the motion, GILDAY refers to the FBI file code named "GIL ROB". Boston has no idea how or where GILDAY may have learned of this code name.

GILDAY was convicted in Suffolk Superior Court, Boston, Mass., in 1971 of Murder, first degree, and armed robbery, in connection with captioned case. He was convicted and sentenced to life imprisonment. He is presently confined at Mass. Correctional Institution, Walpole, Mass.
