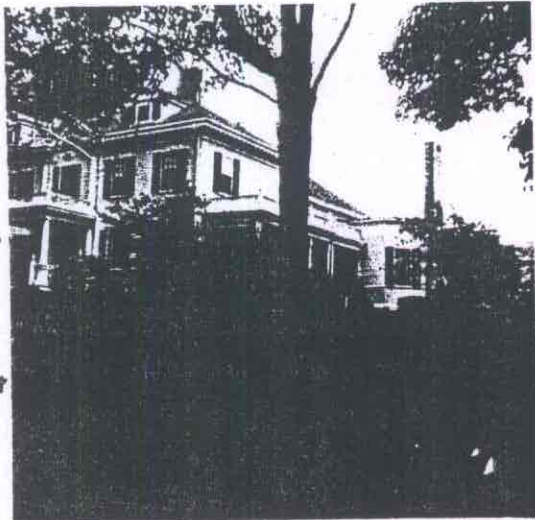


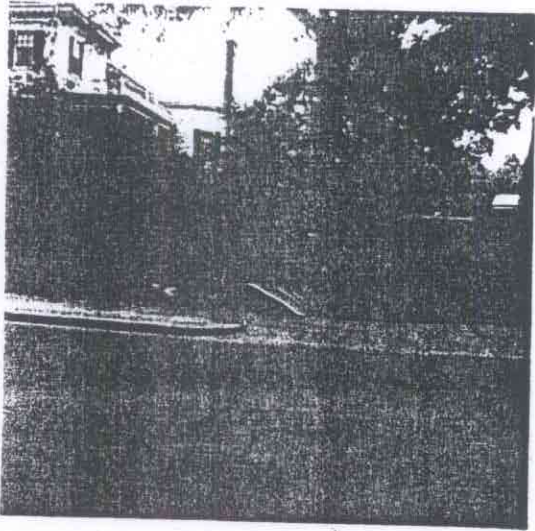

Pic taken same day or next day as others - am unclear.

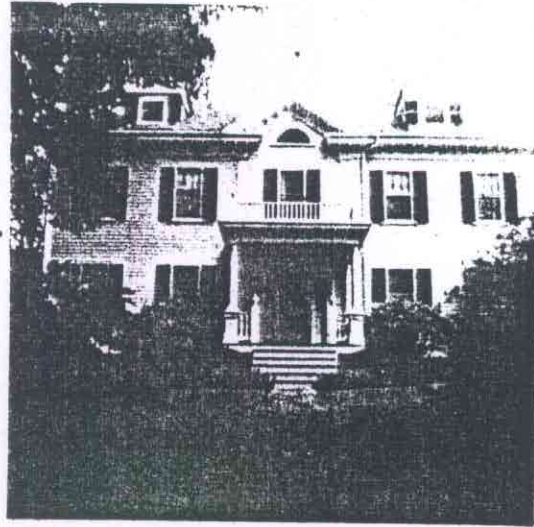


Right side & Driveway of Morin & Colon's Home.

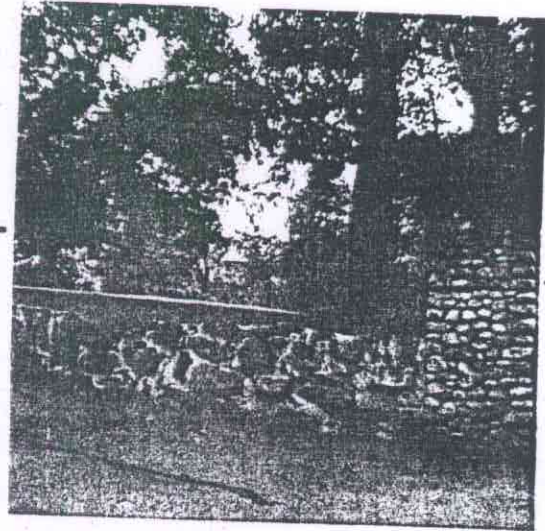
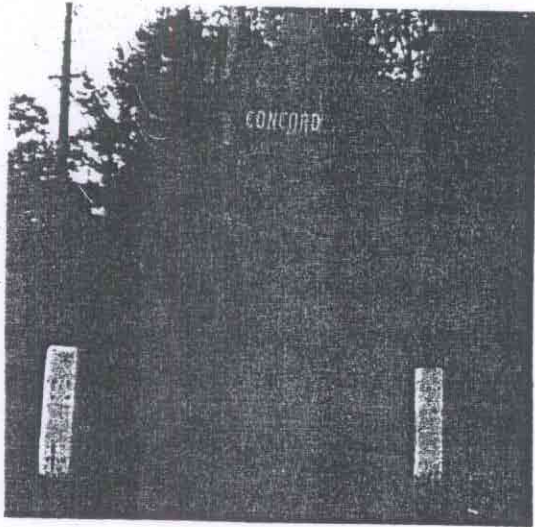


Train Tracks & Crossing to the "right" of driveway & house looking at house.

Sidewalk next to driveway of 11 Concord Road, Wayland, MA, with walls of stones.

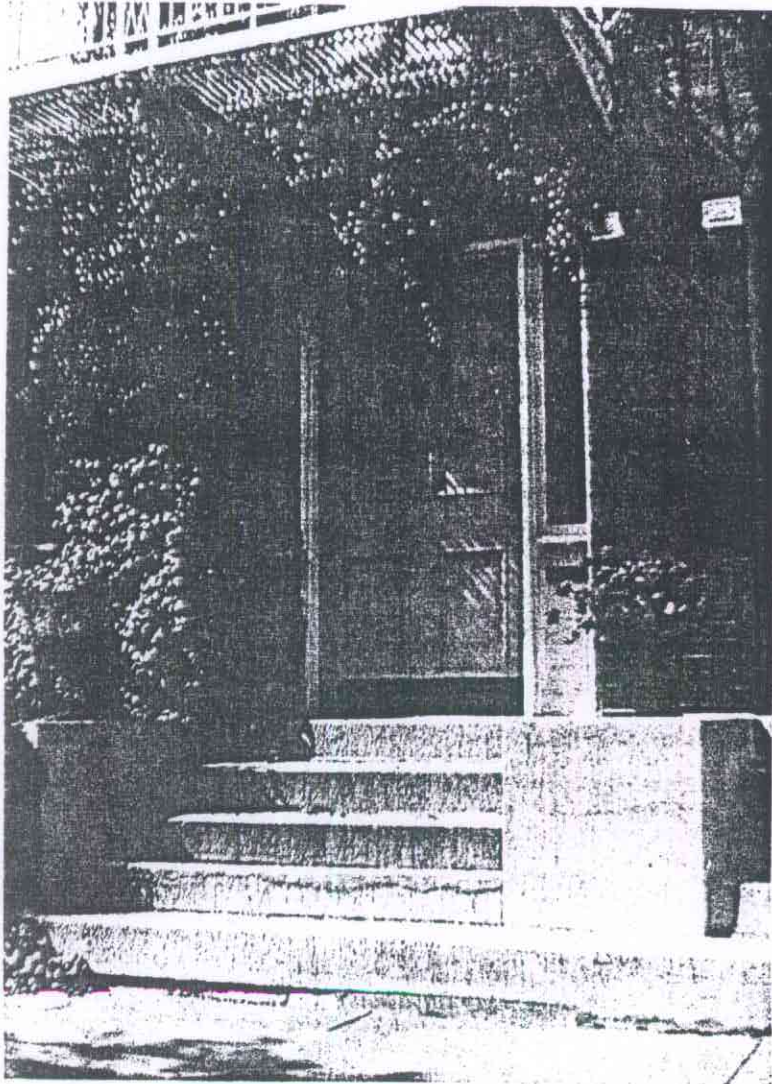


Pic's taken late July or Early Sept., 1970. All pics of both places taken by Stanley Bond and myself.

Another shot of T.K.'s front door from slightly different angle - note that flower pot is next to mail slot beside door.

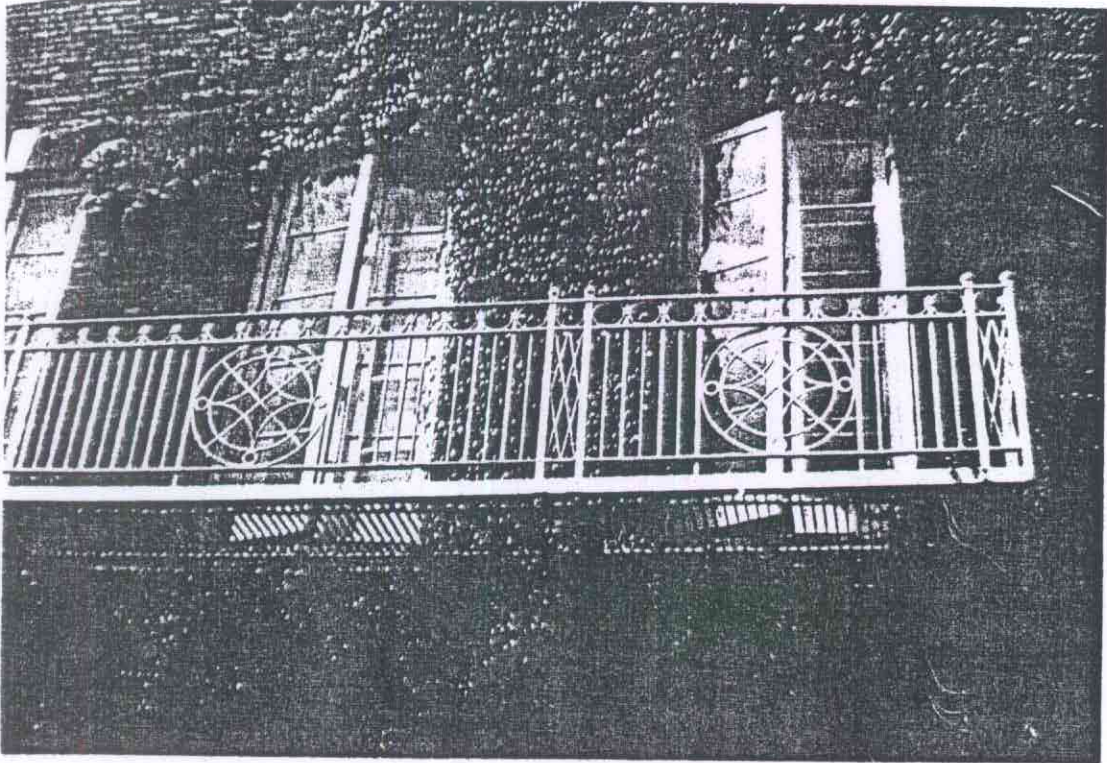

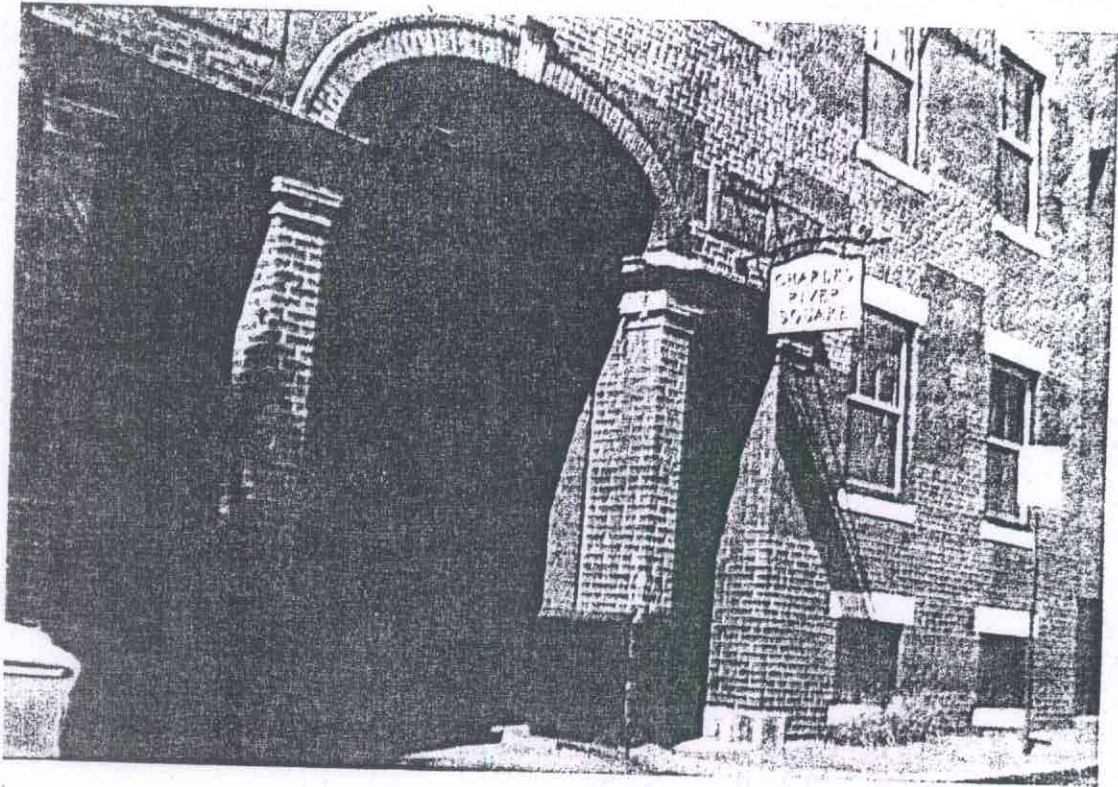
Back 2nd floor balcony of T.K.'s "Town House" - the house is three stories high.

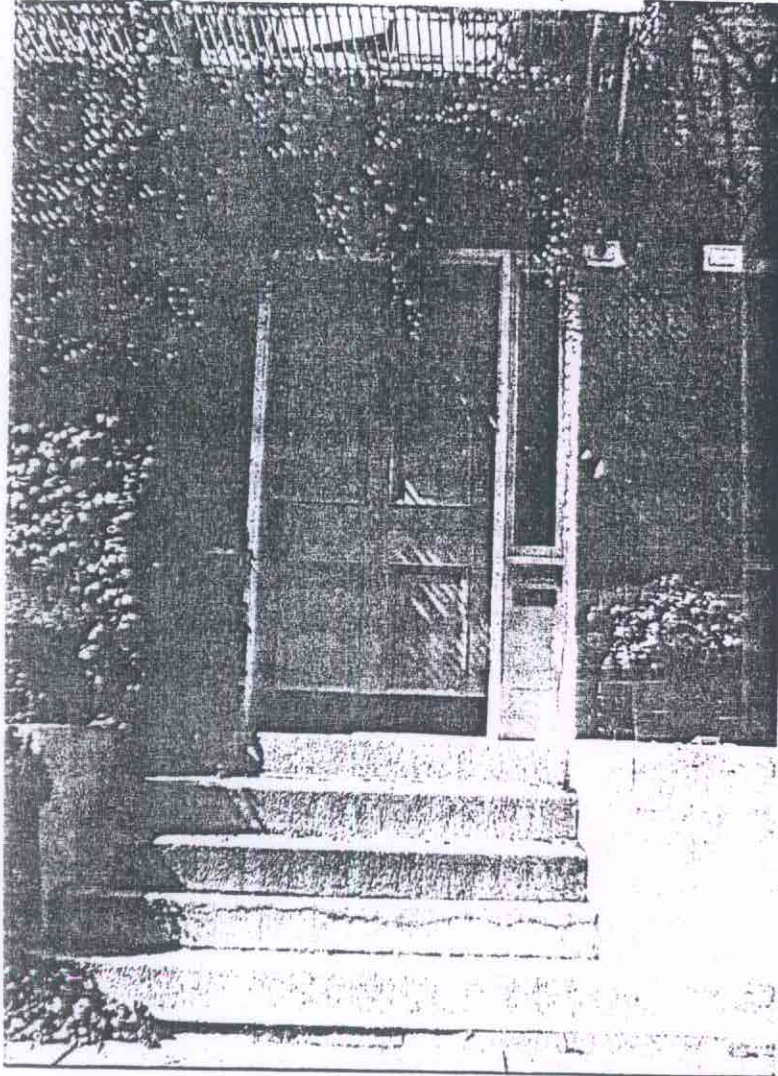
