



And another eyewitness, World War II combat veteran Charles Brehm, who was standing just 20 feet away from JFK's car when the shooting started, told police:
"The car lost momentum, almost as if the driver had taken his foot off the gas.'

This was completely the opposite of Secret Service policy, which required the president's driver to step on the gas and get out of the killing zone as fast as he could, says historian. Harold Weisberg, 78, who has spent 28 years investigating JFK's death.
But Weisberg says that

Greer did more than just slow down — in fact, he actually stopped the car.

"Greer said that after the second shot, he stepped on the gas and raced toward the hospital," says Weisberg. "But according to a film taken that day, the brake light remained on the limo until after the final shot was fired.


