Thanks for your letter. I'm sorry to hear that blood vessel problems plague you but glad you're fine otherwise. A year or so ago I had thrombo-phlebitis in my left leg, which was a horrid sight. In the hospital they fed heparin into my veins to thin the blood and I recovered nicely. I think I know how to clear up other medical problems but it all calls for a special research effort.

I'll get in touch with Dick Sprague and/or Robert Groden on the DCA film question. As you

no doubt know Groden and Prof. John Gordon have put together a one-hour video cassette on the JFK assassination. I'm told it has good motorcade footage.

I've been doing some work on the police tape. Have long since concluded that only independent researchers can - or rather, will - do anything about the whole assassination's problem. And that, somehow, it was meant to be that way.
