- 1. The following changes in future printings of the Report vero requested of GPO on October 7:

  - c. Page 328, para. 3, line 2--insert "had" between "Oswald" and "other."
  - 2. The following changes were requested of GPO on October 12:
    - a. Page 194, para. 2, between footnotes 812 and 613--mait "while" omit coums in next line before "but."
    - b. Page 193, para. 2, line 10-substitute "shot" for "shots."
    - c. Page 259, para. 2, line 9 -- drop "s" from "involvements".
    - d. Page 304, para. 3, line 8--change "p. 306" to "p. 303."
    - e. Page 321, para. 5, lines 1 to 4-change to read:
