These guys, as you can see, are real, believing fascists.

I will be leaving on a three-week trip soon.

Yes, when you can, I'd like any issues you can get. These guys are always, publicly or secretly, anti-semitic also. Whatever pamphlets and tapes you can get without spending money, fine. They can be useful. Indicate most of your interest is in the assassinations and what is behind them, but also bear in mind these publications can be an index to such fascist activity, including by others of the same ilk.

They will like you more if you tell them that Penabaz sees what others do not, that he has an understanding of events not in the "liberal" press and TV, and that there is in this magazine the kind of information that is elsewhere suppressed. Put it that way and you don't even have to cross your fingers! You should also be interested in the plight of the Cubans and what they are doing to recapture their homeland.

Ask Courtney what happened that time he got a call about Oswald being in Florida, or have some other voice do this for you, even a woman's. Ask him what ever happened to those brave Americans who were training in Florida to liberate Cuba, and could he sometime do a special show on them, brave lads! Of course, you heard the government got after them, but why? Courtney did get such a call in '62. It has been so long whoever calls can be vague about the nature of the recollection.
