SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF JOHN F. KENNEDY

On 9/24/75 [REDACTED] advised that an individual named PETER GORMAN from Canada furnished him the following information: He stated that GORMAN arrived in Dallas, Texas on 9/25/75, at the DFW Airport. GORMAN told the source that he is the owner of a wholesale and distributor company called Peter Gorman LTD which has offices at 631 Rivermede Road, Concord Ontario, Canada.

GORMAN advised that he had 8-track tapes regarding comentaries on the Kennedy assassination but that he was afraid to bring them into the Unites States th ough customs for some reason unknown to the source. GORMAN stated that the United States radio media would not play this tape because he stated that it proved that LEE HARVEY OSWALD was a CI Agent and that RICHARD NIXON and GERALD FORD were two people that were responsible for the assassination of President KENNEDY

The source stated that GORMAN also had companies in Toronto, Canada, telephone number 364-6594 and Brampton, Canada, telephone number 451-4534. The Concord, Canada telephone number is 669-1344.

Source desired to know if it was a violation of any FBI jurisdiction to bring in the above mention tapes.

The writer after contacting Agents that work copyright matters told the source that if they were not bootleg tapes and that if the information was not obtained by some sort of illegal wire tap that it did not appear that there was any violation that the FBI would have jurisdiction over. The writer further told the source that there was probably a duty that would have to be paid if the tapes were brought through custom.

Source concluded by stating that GORMAN was staying at the Fairmont Hotel in Dallas, Texas for a few days.
