Are there any other FBI, Secret Service, or CIA reports of such investigations?

CD355:106 makes reference to the interview of PBI SA James W. Russell with Hudkins. I would like a copy of that report, which was not included in what was sent me. It also refers to the possible interview of Mrs. Linda Rosenthal of Fort Worth, which I would like. There is an inference that Mrs. Ruth Paine may have been interviewed on this subject. If she was, I would appreciate a copy of that interview.
