Robert S. Graetz was born in 1928 in Clarksburg, West Virginia. He received his education at Charleston [WV] High School, Capital University (A.B.) and The Evangelical Lutheran Theological Seminary (B.D.).

From 1955 to 1958, Rev. Graetz served at Trinity Lutheran Church in Montgomery, Alabama. During the Montgomery Bus Boycott, he served as Secretary of the Montgomery Improvement Association Board and spoke and wrote for various groups. Throughout his ministerial career he has served as a bridge between black and white ministerial associations in various cities, including a tenure as a member of the Council on Intercultural Education in Columbus, Ohio.

Now in part-time ministry in Logan, Ohio, Rev. Graetz's latest published work is *Montgomery: A White Preacher's Memoir*, Augsburg Fortress Press, 1991.
