MAY 16, 1967

Upon talking to Mr. Bruver over the telephone, I obtained the following information.

Mr. Gruver informed me that approximately 2 or 3 days before the assassination he heard a report over his shortwave radio said to the effect that LEE HARVEY OSWALD was seen crossing the border going into Mexico. GRUVER said that the report originated from somewhere around New Orleans and that OSWALD was traveling alone. Mr. GRUVER said he immediately contacted the F.B.I. and gave them this information and has never heard from the F.B.I. since. He said he would check his log to try and ascertain the name of the person who made the report.

Mr. GRUVER said he is presently employed as a narcotics agent and special detective for the Tucson, Arizona Police.

Mr. GRUVER informed me that he checked with the F.B.I. today and the F.B.I. confirmed to him the fact the he did make this report to the F.B.I. in 1963.
