If the FBI ever returned to interview Guillen, as they should have, I am not aware of it.

It is meaningless for Rolfes not to have known anything.

It is also meaningless to say that at lunch hour Guillen was always around the office.

It would not have been meaningless, in a report going to Washington, to people who presumably knew nothing about New Orleans, to have indicated the close proximity between the National Bank of Commerce Bldg. and the then Trade Mart.
