GUTIERREZ HAS REPORTED UNABLE TO LOCATE ANY RECORD OF CREDIT INVESTIGATION MADE ON OR ABOUT OCTOBER 1 LAST WHICH MIGHT ESTABLISH IDENTITY OF FEMALE CUBAN EMBASSY EMPLOYEE HE CONTACTED AND ESTABLISH EXACT DATE OF THAT CONTACT THROUGH DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE. HE STATED THIS PERSON'S CREDIT APPLICATION WAS REJECTED AND HIS EMPLOYER DOES NOT RETAIN CREDIT REPORTS OR OTHER DOCUMENTS ON REJECTED APPLICANTS FOR CREDIT.
