

Haggerty Qualifies To Run for Judgeship

Edward A. Haggerty Jr. has qualified to run for the Criminal District Court judgeship he was ordered to vacate last November.

Haggerty will run against James L. Alcock, who replaced him after he was removed from the bench.

The former criminal court judge presided over the trial in which Clay Shaw was found innocent of conspiring to assassinate President John F. Kennedy.

HAGGERTY WAS removed from the bench by the Louisiana Supreme Court because of his arrest Dec. 17, 1969, in a stag party at a New Orleans motel. He was acquitted of all charges in connection with the arrest.

Four candidates for the state Senate, one candidate for state representative, and eight candidates for the parish committee also qualified yesterday with the Orleans Parish Democratic Executive Committee to run in the Nov. 6 Democratic Primary election.

At stake in the election are six senate seats from four senatorial districts and 18 House seats from 11 representative districts as well as 54 seats on the parish committee from the same 11 districts.

PROSPECTIVE candidates can qualify through Friday and on Monday of next week from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. at committee headquarters, 445 S. Rampart St.
