

Haggerty Case Is Allotted to Judge Oser

Judge Alvin V. Oser today was allotted the case of his fellow Criminal District Court judge, Edward A. Haggerty Jr., who was charged Wednesday with soliciting for prostitution, exhibiting "sexually indecent" motion pictures and resisting arrest.

Judge Oser received the allotment this morning in the Clerk of Court's office. Present were assistant D.A. Michael Karmazin, Numa V. Bertel and Harry Wheeler.

Judge Haggerty, who presided over the conspiracy trial of Clay L. Shaw early last year, was arrested Dec. 17 in a vice squad raid at the DeVille Motel, 3800 Tulane.

Sixteen others were arrested during and after the raid on the alleged "stag show."

Judge Haggerty began his annual vacation yesterday. His attorney, Robert Zibilich, said on the judge's behalf that a "speedy trial" will be sought so the judge "may resume the bench at the earliest possible date."
