## Haiti Seeks Surrender of

Air Raiders

June 6-Foreign Minister Rene Chalmers said Friday the British government will be asked to surrender any Haiti-ans involved in Wednesday's fire bombing of the city.

Unverified reports received

Unverified reports received here said seven Americans and two Haltans were about the aircraft and were arrested later in the British Bahamas. The bombing plane, a fourgine Constellation without national markings, dropped eight gasoline-filled drums on Port Au-Prince at noon Wednesday, leaving six known dead and causing minor damdead and causing minor dam-

President Francois Duvalier told the nation by radio yesterday that the aircraft came from South Catego in the Bahamas, about 200 air miles north of here.

Three persons died directly as the result of the bombing, the government said. Among them was the six-month-old daughter of the gardener of U.S. Ambassador Claude G. Ross.
