

Hameli's legal bills exceed state salary

The excellent column by Ron Williams May 23 says that Dr. Ali Hameli has been paid more than \$210,000 in salary while not working since his suspension in 1994. The article does not say that Dr. Hameli has always been ready and eager to return to work, but the state has not permitted that.

Nor does it say that during the time of his suspension Dr. Hameli has incurred legal bills that total far more than the salary he received.

Yes it is time to settle this case.
