

Resist Summons ^{Cook} 8.2.77

CHICAGO—Three Black Panther attorneys subpoenaed to testify in a hearing that has interrupted the trial of Cook County State's Attorney Edward V. Hanrahan argued yesterday they should not be forced to take the stand.

The three said information which the Black Panthers had given them was privileged under law and they could not divulge it. They asked that the subpoenas be quashed and the hearing be discontinued.

Defense attorneys argued that the Panther lawyers had some information which was not privileged and that they should be forced to testify. Circuit Court Judge Philip Romiti said he would rule on the matter today.
