

Hanrahan Case Halt Refused

CHICAGO—A Circuit Court judge refused yesterday to halt a special hearing of new evidence which State's Attorney Edward V. Hanrahan and his 13 codefendants contend shows they were indicted on perjured grand jury testimony.

Four lawyers for Black Panthers had asked an end to the special hearing. They contended it was a "fishing expedition" by counsel for Hanrahan and others of the defense.

Judge Philip Ronati rejected the argument of the Panther lawyers and directed that the hearing proceed.
