## Hanrahan Trial

CHICAGO—The trial of Cook County State's Attorney Edward V. Hanrahan and 13 codefendants in the Black Panther case was postponed for five days yesterday so a defense attorney could take a vacation.

Circuit Court Judge Philip Romiti denied a request for a three-week delay.

The judge, however, granted a defense request for the five-day continuance so attorney Thomas Sullivan, representing eight of the indicted policemen, could take a vacation. The move opened the way to possible further continuances due to a complex legal point.
